This is the second issue of the first edition, with errors corrected on pages 9 and 88. Goldstone A7b.





Darkening and a few small abrasions to jacket spine, else very light wear to jacket; boards are crisp and unworn, with light toning to spine and extremities; interior unmarked. [54665] **\$300**


